English: In English we will be reading 'Lost and Found' and 'The Emperors Egg'. During this unit we will be retelling the story in our own words, writing a poem and writing an information text.

Maths: In Maths we will be looking at place value within 50 as well as continuing to learn about multiplication and division. For weeks 3-6 we will be looking at height and length as well as mass and volume. RE: Easter: How do symbols help us to understand the story. In this unit children will gain an understanding that symbols are picture and objects with a deeper meaning and a story to tell. It will extend pupils knowledge of the details of the Easter story.

<u>Geography</u>: In Geography we will compare the polar region to the equator, looking at physical and human features of geography as well as the climate. We will discuss where a penguin lives and the reasons for that.

<u>Art:</u> In this unit children will look at work inspired by flora and fauna. They will create their own pieces of art inspired by others.

<u>Science:</u> In Science we will be learning about everyday materials. The children will learn about a range of materials and their properties are.

<u>PSHE:</u> Conflict resolution – Children will learn about solutions and ways to express how they feel. Focusing on positive ways to solve our problems and help our friends who are in similar situa-

Computing:

The computing unit for this half term spreadsheets. Children will learn to solve problems and create a block graph.

<u>Music:</u> In this unit the children will focus on a song called 'round and round'. Children will learn to sing the song as well as play it on instruments.

<u>PE:</u> This unit is personal skills unit. Children will learn to challenge themselves. They will focus on static balancing skills as well as their coordination.

<u>Homework:</u> Homework will be set every <u>Friday</u> and must be returned the following <u>Thursday</u>. This includes reading books which need to be returned to be changed. Children need to read their books and fill out their reading records. We encourage all parents to listen to their child read and to also sign the reading record to confirm the book has been read. The children will have their homework and reading book in their homework folders on Fridays.
