English: In English we will be reading 'The Rotten Romans' and 'A Roman Soldier's Handbook'. We will be linking our learning in history to help us to write Roman diaries, a persuasive speech and a non-chronological report. The children will be learning to write in the first person, use pronouns, choose specific vocabulary and to use fronted adverbials.

<u>Maths:</u> In Maths we will be focussing on Number and Place Value; we will then moving onto addition and subtraction using written methods and mental strategies.

Children need to read their books and fill out their reading records. We encourage all parents to listen to their child read and to also sign the reading record to confirm the book has been read. The children will have their homework and reading book in their homework folders on Friday.
