English: In English we will be reading 'The Lost Happy Endings' by Carol Ann Duffy and the children will be writing diaries and character profiles. We will also be linking our English to our topic and we will be writing reports about earthquakes and instructions on how to stay safe dusting an earth-

Science: In Science we will be learning about forces and magnets and will be carrying out investigations. The children will also be learning about Earth and Space, this will link to our geography topic.

Geography: We will be learning 'What makes the world grumble and ' This will be a study of earthquakes and how they occur. The children will also develop their locational knowledge and access lots of map work. Topic: What makes the world grumble and shake? An in depth study on Earthquakes



Art and Design: The children will be studying birds nests. We will be developing our observational drawing skills using a range of materials. WE will also make our own birds nests sculptures using twigs and natural materials.

<u>RE:</u> The children will be learning about Churches– 'Are all churches the same?' They will also be learning about Harvest. **PSHE:** The children will be learning about 'What strengths, skills and interests do we have?'

Computing: The children will be exploring retrieving and organising data, this will include inputting data and interpreting data bases. They will be looking at spreadsheets and will create their own. We will also look at E-safety and keeping ourselves safe on line.

<u>Music:</u> This term we will be looking at some AB-BA songs. We will be singing the songs and adding instruments. We will also be creating our own compositions and performing them.

<u>PE:</u> Year 5 children will be going swimming and Year 4 children will be working with the Sports Development team.

Homework: Homework will be set every **<u>Friday</u>** and must be return the following **<u>Wednesday</u>**. This includes reading books which need to be returned to be changed. Children need to read their books and fill out their reading records. We encourage all parents to listen to their child read and to also sign the reading record to confirm the book has been read. The children will have their homework and reading book in their homework folders on Friday.

<u>Key Information</u>: PE lessons are every **Friday** afternoon and full kits should be in school for these lessons (Year 4 children). Year 5 children will be swimming every **Wednesday** afternoon and will need swimming kit.
