### Investors in Pupils

We are writing to let you know about an award that our school is applying for. We are applying for an award called Investors in Pupils and we wanted to tell you all about it.

The Investors in Pupils award is based around 5 areas which are learning, induction, behaviour, attendance and classroom management. We wanted to let you know about each of the areas and what they mean.

(1) Learning – for Investors in Pupils, everyone chooses their own learning target to (2) work towards. It can be for anything at all that you find tricky, not just writing or number work.

(2) Induction - this word is to do with how we make visitors or new people feel welcome in our classrooms and school. Your room should have a special “**Induction Book**” to show them all about our class.

(3) Attendance - this word is to do with coming to school and coming on time.

(4) Classroom Management - this is to do with keeping our classrooms clean and tidy.

(5) Behaviour all of our classes have agreed a set of rules or a “**Mission Statement**” which says how we want our class to be. Everyone must try hard to make their class the best it can be.
