### Record Breakers!!!



A group of St Anne's KS2 children attended Mahdlo and took part in the attempt to break the current Guinness World record for 'Most people doing sit-ups simultaneously' which was held by by Sysmex Corporation (Japan) in Kobe, Hyogo, Japan, on 19 October 2013 whose record was set at 263 people. The attempt at Mahdlo set their target to break the record with 300 participants with children from Oldham Schools. They smashed the current record achieving 369 participants (official confirmation pending). The Children that attended were a credit to the school and the event organisers commented on the excellent behaviour of all the children in attendance.
