### URGENT : Inhalers in school



Can we please remind all parents/carers that if your child has been diagnosed with asthma (even if they do not use an inhaler regularly) that your child must have an in date inhaler in school for in case of emergency no matter how rare they may need it.

If you are unsure if your child has an in date inhaler in school please see your child's teacher as a matter of urgency.



### Polling Day Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2014

### Late Procedure

Can we please remind parents and carers that if your child arrives at school after 9am you need to report to the office. There are 2 main reasons for this:



**1. Late children will be put on the fire register in the office.**

Children that are late may have been marked in the class register as absent and the register may have already left the class for processing. This could mean that if there was a fire; the fire service might not be alerted that a child that had been marked as absent on a register could be trapped. If they are on the Fire Register in the office as arriving late the fire service would be notified and would know who to look for.



**2. Late children may have missed their class.**

If lesson plans mean that the class will not be in the classroom (i.e. assembly or if the class has a lesson planned in a different part of the school) a late child could be going into a class where there is no supervision. This is not only distressing for your child but also a safety issue.



**Please ensure that unless your child goes into school along with the rest of their class that they are brought to the school office to ensure they are marked on the fire register and can be taken by a member of staff who will ensure that they are placed in the supervision of their class teacher.**

### HATS AND SUNCREAM

Could we please ask that you get into the habit of making sure that your child has sun cream applied each morning and brings a hat into school each day for wearing when they are outside. Although we don't often have brilliant sunshine children's delicate skin can burn even on cloudy days.
