Primary Admissions

Parents of Nursery children will need to complete a Local Authority application form for Reception online. **Children attending our Nursery are not automatically allocated a place in Reception.** Your online application needs to be submitted before the deadline which **closes at 5.00pm on 15 January 2015.** If you need any further advice please contact Primary Admissions on: 0161 770 4214, 0161 770 4213 or 0161 770 4201.

You can choose in which way you would prefer to be notified of which school your child has been allocated a place (either by email or post) If you opt to be notified by email you will receive an email on 16th April 2015. If you opt to be notified by post you will receive a letter by 2nd class post to your home address. If you have not received a letter by 23rd April 2015 please telephone 0161 770 4213. St Anne's school will not be able to inform you which school your child has been allocated.



Secondary Application Forms



Parent/Carers of children that will be going to secondary school in September 2015 need to complete a Local Authority application online. Your online application for secondary school are completed online. The deadline is **31st October 2011.**

If you selected to be informed of which school your child has be offered by email, you will receive an email before 12 noon on 2 March 2015. If you selected to be informed of which school your child has be offered by post, the letter will be sent to your home address on 2 March 2015 by second class post. If you do not receive a letter by 11 March 2015, phone 0161 770 4213.

Parentmail

ParentMail is an online system, which allows school and parents to keep in touch electronically.

ParentMail allows you to receive emails (news letters, events information, school trip information etc) receive text messages from school, pay for school dinners and school trips.

Overall ParentMail is an easier way for school to keep in touch with parents and it also means an end to sending cash into school with your child. Should you wish to find out more about the system or wish to start receiving emailed newsletters and text messages then please do not hesitate to contact the office who will be happy to assist you with any queries you have and provide you with a registration code.
