- 3rd Mrs Ali's class (Green) with 99.33%



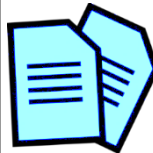
These are very impressive attendance figures so we would like to say a huge thank you to everyone that helped us to achieve these fantastic attendance results.
