The whole school attendance for WC 12/01/15 was 97.43% which was lower than last week when overall attendance was at 98.56%, but still above our target of 96.5%.

Tooth friendly

Over the past few years we have managed to implement some important changes in our school. These have been well supported by parents. Our school is now committed to maintaining the Tooth Friendly Award. The award is a positive one for our school and to achieve this we need your support.



Part of the award looks at healthy snacks and drinks brought into school or supplied by school. We encourage children to have fruit or

vegetables at break and water is available to them all the time. In order to maintain our current status of Platinum award, we ask that children only bring in fresh fruit or vegetables for playtime snacks. Infants will continue to be provided with fruit and milk. *Dried fruit and cereal bars contain more sugar than we think and so these are not allowed for break time snacks. Fizzy drinks and energy drinks are also not allowed to be brought into school.*

Instead of children bringing sweets to share for their birthdays, we ask that they if they want to bring in a gift that they bring in any non-sweet items , for example, pencils, balloons and rubbers etc.

We are working alongside other primary schools to ensure children get into good, healthy eating habits and keep their teeth clean. Thanks once again for your support.

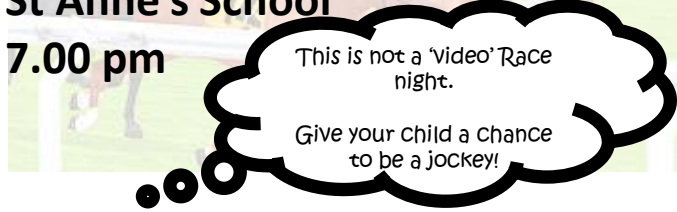

Adverse Weather Conditions School Procedure

During severe weather conditions, such as flooding or snow, it may be necessary to close the school temporarily due to inaccessibility or risk of injury.



The decision to close will only be made in exceptional circumstances if weather conditions pose risks to children's safety and welfare. This may be due to transport or travel issues (coming to school or going home), the safety of our school sites (including possible damage caused) or low staff ratios due to difficulties getting into school.

Children's safety is always our priority and we will remain open unless it would be a high risk to do so.

If the decision to close is made we will communicate with parents in the following ways:
