Attendance

The whole school attendance for WE 08/04/16 was 93.31% This means that this week's attendance was below our target of 96.5%. Keep aiming high. Every minute of every day counts.

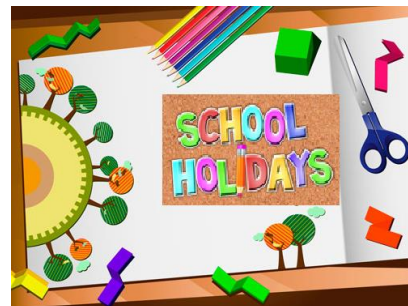
