Attendance

The whole school attendance for WE 06/05/16 was 97.48% This means that this week's attendance was above our target of 96.5%. Well done. Thank you for your continued support.

Each school day is 6 hrs. This week 8.42 hours of education were lost due to appointments and 3.75 hours due to lateness. We need your help to reduce these figures. If an appointment is unavoidable (e.g. hospital appointments) please ensure your child attends school before and after it- every minute of every day counts! Thank you.

Reporting Absences

Please be aware that if your child is absent from school ,and you do not contact us to report the absence , it will be recorded as an unauthorised. Unauthorised absences can be picked up by the attendance service . This could result in you receiving a Fixed Penalty Notice and possibly a visit from the School Attendance Officer. You may be required to supply medical evidence for your child's absence and this could be a printed prescription label or medical appointment proof to support your child's absence.

Contact needs to be made on each day of absence before 9am.

Changes to school dinners

To enable our kitchen staff to order and prepare the correct amount of food each day we will need a full week of notice for your child to go on or off school dinners.

This will be starting week commencing 6th June. You can either let the office know by sending a note in to class with your child, or by emailing info@stannesroyton.oldham.sch.uk



Unfortunately this means that we will also need to enforce that children will need to be on school meals each day and not pick individual days.

School dinners for children in Reception to Yr2

From September 2014, all children in Reception, Y1 and Y2, in state-funded schools in England are eligible for free school meals. This is not means tested. All infant children are entitled to a free school.

Children in Yr3 to Yr6

Dinners are charged at £10 a week **which must be paid in advance.** **Dinners must be paid each Monday for the week ahead.** You can either put your child's dinner money in an envelope labelled 'Dinner Money'. Please ensure you put your child's name and class on the envelope too, or you can pay by Parentmail using a credit/debit card or paypal.



Are you entitled to Free School Meals?

You can get free school meals if your child attends a local authority maintained school (not private) and you receive certain benefits. To apply or find out if you are eligible please visit Oldham Council's website or contact Access Oldham (Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham, OL1 1UG, Tel 0161 770 3000)
