Dear Parents,

This week in English, we have continued working on The Pied Piper of Hamelin by Michael Morpurgo. We have focused descriptive language, including powerful verbs and adverbs. We have looked at how the rats moved through Hamelin town and we have planned a letter from the Pied Piper.

In maths, we have started to look at addition. We have introduced the formal written method and have been carrying numbers over. Some children have found this quite difficult.
