English

We have been learning to correctly form the letters z,x,w and v and sit them on the line. The children have been writing the words fox, van, zip and web and writing their own sentences. I have been very impressed with their presentation.

Maths

This week we have been counting up to one hundred. We have been using hundred squares to count on from a given number. For example, I start at 23, which number comes next? We have also been problem solving this week. The children have been trying to find all possibilities. For example; ***I have seven counters and three pots, how many different ways can I put the counters into two pots?***

Homework

This week your child is coming home with a reading book. Please listen to your child read at least 10 minutes each evening.

Reception homework – we are encouraging children to listen to the initial sounds in words. Please work with your child to see if they can hear the first sound in the word and then write the correct letter. E.g. a for apple

Year 1 homework - we are encouraging children to hear the sounds in three and four letter words. Please work with your child to hear the sounds, write the word and then think of a simple sentence. Please return this homework to school by Wednesday of the following week. Thank you.
