Dear Parents,

Here's what we've been up to this week...

English

Year 1 – The children have been learning to use capital letters and full stops in our sentences. They are becoming much better at this and I have been very impressed with their presentation.

Reception - The children have been focusing on their letter formation of the letters s, a, t, p and h. They have also been listening to the initial sounds in words and writing these.

Maths

Year 1 – The children have been ordering numbers from the smallest to the largest. They have found this quite challenging. The homework sheet this week is to reinforce this work. The children used a number line to help them to see which number came first.

Reception – The children have been learning about the value of numbers up to ten. They have been recognising the numbers then going to find that many objects. At first, they found this quite difficult. They were returning with many more items than they were asked for. However, by the end of the week they have become much more confident with this.

Science

We are learning about our senses in Science. This week we have been learning about our sense of hearing. The children enjoyed listening carefully as we passed the egg shaker around the circle trying not to make a sound! We then did a guess the sound quiz where the children had to listen to the sound and find the object on their sheet. Great listening Yellow class!

Topic

We have compared a village, a town and a city. The children have discussed which one they like best and why.

Homework

This week your child is coming home with a reading book. Please listen to your child read at least 10 minutes each evening.

Reception homework – This week the children have been asked look at a number and collect that many items. It is suggested that you go on an Autumn walk for this as there should be a number of natural things on the ground such as leaves and pine cones.

Year 1 homework - The children have to order the numbers from the smallest to the largest.
