# Weekly Newsletter

Dear Parents,

Welcome back! We hope you have had a lovely summer! The children have settled into Lime Class really well and we have spent time getting to know each other. In English this week we have started working on *The Pied Piper of Hamelin* by Michael Morpurgo. We have done lots of descriptive work and have focused on describing the town of Hamelin, the rats and the characters. We have also worked on basic punctuation reinforcing the importance of capital letters and full stops. In maths, we have been working on place value. Year 3 have concentrated on 3 digit numbers and Year 4 have moved onto numbers up to 10,000. We have looked at the value of the digits, numbers greater and less than and 1,10, 100 and 1000 more/ less than given digits.

## Homework

Homework is given out on a Friday and needs to be returned on the following Wednesday. French homework will be a list of words which are sent home on a Tuesday for the children to practice saying ready for the following Tuesday.

This week for homework we are sending home a list of the Year 3/ 4 spellings. The children need to be able to spell these by the end of the year so please begin to familiarise your children with the list.

We have a class library and we are encouraging the children to sign books out that they want to take home.

**Maths:** Making and ordering 3/ 4 digit numbers (see sheet).

**English:** Highlight all of the nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs in the paragraph (highlight in different colours and include a key).
