This week in English, we have continued working on our new class text 'Roman Diary the Journal of Iliona a young slave girl'. We have looked at Iliona being forced into slavery and being auctioned with her little brother. We have been focusing on the character's feelings and the children have been really empathizing with them. This book links to our new topic 'Why were the Romans so powerful and what did we learn from them?'

In maths, we have been looking at multiplication and division. Year 4 have worked on multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100, we have been identifying and explaining patterns. We have also been multiplying and dividing by 1 and 0 and again explaining what happens. Year 3 have been multiplying and dividing by 4 and have been learning the 3 and 4 time tables.
