This week we have been learning:

This week in English we have been learning how to write an information text. We researched facts and learnt about how we need to set our work out different for an information text. Thank you for taking time to read the knowledge organiser with your child; it was great to see so many of the children able to recall the facts they had read. In Maths we solved Addition and Subtraction puzzles. We then revisited Multiplication and Division strategies. In Science we looked at different flowers and compared the structural parts. As part of our PSHE learning we discussed why it is important to listen to others and how we can be good listeners.
