Dear Parents,

This week in English, we have continued working on 'The Promise'. We have been collecting lots of descriptive language and we have re-written parts of the story in our own words. We have focused on using fronted adverbials, prepositions and noun phrases. We have also worked on the authorial intent of Nicola Davies writing this story. We have written letters to the author Nicola Davies and we are going to send them to her.

In maths, we have been looking at multiplication and division. We have moved onto formal written methods and have been using 2 and 3 digit numbers. The children started off using place value counters and then moved away from them.

Homework:

Science: What are the features of amphibians, mammals, reptiles, birds and fish. Think of examples of each type of animal.

Maths: Multiply a 2 digit number by a single digit- **show your working out.**

34 x 6 e.g:

5 x 43

4 x 45

= 6 x 27

= 44 x 4

= 7 x 54

Talk Homework: God's Smuggler: *To recognise that achieving a goal can sometimes require overcoming obstacles and a lot of perseverance.*

Talk: **Have you ever overcome obstacles to achieve something? Have you ever felt like giving up? Who encourages you to keep going?**
