## What have we been doing this week?

**Maths:** This week we have been learning how to use a part, part whole to partition numbers in different ways and how to finding missing parts. For example. 34 can be partitioned as  $30 + 4$ ,  $20 + 14$  and  $10 + 24$ .

**English:** This week in English we have written a postcard as if we were Polar and we have been planning our retell of the story ready for next week. We are going to write the story as if we are Polar and think about what he did before he went on The Titanic, his time on The Titanic and what happened after the crash.

## Homework

**Maths:** Partitioning numbers. Use a part, part whole to help

**English** - Noun phrases.

**Spelling** - Copy out the spellings.

**Talk Homework** - Do you know anyone who finds it hard to make friends? How do you think that makes them feel? Think about the way you speak to them. Can you use your words to build them up and make them feel better about themselves?
