This week we have been learning:

In English this week the children have focussed on writing information texts about Treacher Collins's syndrome. This is the syndrome that the little boy in 'Wonder' (Auggie) has. The children have completed research and have had to answer the question: "Is Treacher-Collins Syndrome a result of evolution or inheritance?" They have completed fact sheets and we are very pleased with the results.

In maths we have recapped on shape and in particular calculating angles using our prior knowledge of shape. The children have also used timetables and costed out three different methods of transport to get to York. They then had to plan which buses/ trains they would have to catch to get to York from school and ensure they arrived before 10:00am.

Homework (handed out on a Wednesday and due in the following Wednesday)

English: Semi- colons and colons.

Maths: Calculating the mean (average).

Knowledge Organiser: We will continue our topic work after SAT's.

Spelling: Individual spelling lists.

Talk Homework: Think about the choices you make each day. Do you choose to be kind and helpful? Do you try to serve others by not always thinking about yourself? Do you care for others gladly?
