This week we have been learning:

This week we have introduced our new topic to the children which is 'Out of an Egg', we have been talking about which animals hatch from an egg and which ones don't.

This week we have had an egg incubator in our classroom, this is a very exciting opportunity which will allow children to have a hands on experience. The children have been able to watch 9 of the eggs hatch into little chicks, next week the children will then enjoy taking care of them. On occasions the children will be allowed to handle the chicks under supervision
