This week we have been learning:

This week in Maths we revisited multiplication strategies and then began learning about Fraction. In English we learnt more about Information Texts and wrote one independently. In Science we continued to learn about Plants. In topic we used images to work out how 'great' the fire was and then thought about why it spread so far. In RE we began learning about the importance of Bread and Wine as symbols at Easter.
