Dear Parents,

Thank you for all the donations for our class Summer Fair. The children had a wonderful time even though we were unable to get outdoors. We had a raffle, a toy stall, a book stall and a three legged race. This has really helped the children to understand what these words mean. We read our class book 'Dogger' again and the children were able to understand more about the story. It was great practice for the children to buy the items with their 2p, 5p and 10p coins. We need a little bit of extra practice with choosing the correct coins. This week's homework is extra practice of counting coins in 2s, 5s and 10s.

This week we have been learning:

- To write about what we would like to buy at the Summer Fair
- To use coins to count in 2s, 5s and 10s .
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Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

This week's homework is to use coins (2ps, 5ps and 10ps) to pay for the items. Please do this practically with your child, maybe set a 'shop' up at home and ask them to buy the items with their coins. Try to keep the amounts no more than 20p and encourage your child to pay for the item in **all** 2ps, **all** 5ps or **all** 10ps (so they can practice counting in 2s,5s and 10s.)

Spellings for this week will contain a mixture of Phase five sounds. **Please encourage your child to read the words first.**
