This week we have been learning:

This week we have been learning about sharing. Children have learnt how to share groups of objects equally into 2 or 3. This is the first stages of division. Children have also been listening to 'That's not my' Stories and have been learning key words ready to write our own story next week.

Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

Please can you use objects from around your house to practise sharing into 2 or 3 equal groups.

E.g. Can you share 4 apples equally between 2 people (Each person would have 2)

Can you share 6 biscuits equally between 2?

Can you share 9 sweets equally between 3 people?

These are just example. Please feel free to use other objects, sticker etc.

Ask children to check they have shared them equally by counting and checking each group has the same amount of objects.

PE will be on a Thursday morning each week. Please ensure your child has the correct kit in school and any earrings are removed or covered for this day.


There is also a calendar of events on the website. If you do not have internet access or cannot use this website for any reason, then please come and see me.
