## This week we have been learning:

We have been writing our own versions of The Flower by John Light in English. We have been including dialogue in our story telling. We have completed our topic about flowering plants in science and continued designing sandwiches in DT. In maths we have been working on comparing and ordering fractions. In PE we have moved on to rounders.

## Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

**English:** Complete the fronted adverbials.

**Maths:** Focus on x4 tables and division facts. Practise telling the time to the nearest hour, half and quarter hours.

**Knowledge Organiser:** Read through the definitions of the different parts of flowering plants.

**Spelling:** Words with a sh sound spelt with ch.

**Talk Homework:** Discuss what makes healthy food – what kind of ingredients do you think would make a healthy sandwich? Think of the food pyramid.

PE will be on a Wednesday each week. Please ensure your child has the correct kit in school – please note it is still quite chilly so outdoor PE clothing is appropriate.
