This week we have been learning:

This week in English, we have started working on a story called Orion and the Dark. We have focused on writing dialogue and using inverted commas. We have also looked at writing noun phrases, expanded noun phrases and prepositional phrases. In maths, Year 3 have looked at finding fractions of quantities, comparing and ordering fractions and adding fractions. Year 4 have worked on tenths and we have related this to decimals. We have been dividing one digit numbers by 10 to find decimals.
