This week we have been learning:

This week in English, we have been working on a story called The Adventures of Robin Hood. We have been looking at turning parts of the story into diaries for the different characters. We have also been coming up with different pronouns for Robin Hood. In maths, Year 3 have looked at time and have focused on telling the time on analogue clocks. We have practiced telling the time to every five minutes and have been ordering times. Year 4 have also started to work on time and have been looking at years, months, weeks, hours, minutes and seconds. They have also started to look at digital times.
