This week we have been learning:

The children really enjoyed meeting all of the different creatures during our Zoolab experience last week. This week we have been learning about where the different creatures live and learning some interesting animal facts. Children have written some excellent animal fact sheets and I am very proud of the progress they have all made.

Next Friday we will be celebrating our love of books. Children are asked to come dressed as their favourite book character, please can you also bring in the book which features that character and a £1 donation. (please clearly label with your child's name).

Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

Literacy – Some words we have learnt this week that children have found interesting are; camouflage, transparent, herbivore, carnivore, omnivore – please can you spend time talking to your child about these words in relation to animals e.g. The flies wings are transparent. The frog can camouflage.

Phonics – Practise writing words with the **ee** phoneme. Such as see, meet, beep, deep etc. (Say the word to your child and ask them to sound talk and write the phonemes they can hear.

Mathematics – Throughout the year we have been learning about doubles and the children have learnt a doubles poem. Please can you spend time reciting doubles to 5 e.g. double 1 is 2. On Youtube there is a Double Rap song which is fun. If you and your child has access to the internet it may be something you watch and learn together.

Talk Homework – What do you find hard to understand? Who helps you to understand things you find confusing?
