## **This week we have been learning:**

This week in English, we have continued working on The Adventures of Robin Hood and we have linked this to writing persuasive speeches. We have looked at persuasive speeches by William Wallace and the Gladiator. We have mainly speech called 'The Chieftains Speech the Villagers'. In maths, we have continued telling the time and the children have found this a challenge. Please keep practicing with your child using analogue clocks.

## **Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)**

**Maths:** Time analogue- minutes to and past to the nearest minute.

**English:** Watch the Chieftains Speech the Villagers on <https://youtu.be/-6hnOB48voY> Write a brief review- what features has she used? Is it persuasive? How?

**Knowledge Organiser: Charter-** an official document setting out the rights and duties of a group.

**Baron-** a member of the lowest order of the British nobility, usually referred to as a Lord.

**Spelling:** Words with the /k/ sound spelt ch (Greek in origin) (*character, chemist*)

**Talk Homework:** Learn to live with it- Genesis 13: 8-18

*To understand that our lives and the lives of others can be changed by the choices we make.*

**Talk: How do we feel when others make choices for us? How can we use our imagination to adapt to situations where someone else has made the choice?**
