**This week we have been learning:**

We have been learning some facts about Beatrix Potter for example, when she was born, that she had a younger brother and that she was an illustrator as well as an author. We have also been putting the illustrations of Peter Rabbit in chronological order.

In Maths work we have been counting in tens and relating this to multiplication facts.

**Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)**

**English:** Write about your favourite food

**Maths:** Practice counting in tens. You do not need to formally record this.

**Spelling rules:** Use the prefix un (e.g. **un**happy, **un**kind)

**Phonics:** Reception. Read the following words – feet, rain, night, boat and zoom

**Talk Homework: How do we feel when others make choices for us? How can we use our imagination to adapt to situations where someone else has made the choice?**
