
Please see the attached regarding our Rainbow Run which is happening on Friday 5th July

Literacy – Read your reading books and talk to someone about what is happening and the different characters in the story.

Phonics – Practise writing words with the **igh** phoneme. Such as light, night, might, tonight. (Say the word to your child and ask them to sound talk and write the phonemes they can hear.)

Mathematics – Can you look around your homes or garden for any objects that remind you of 3D shapes. E.g. a ball is like a sphere, a tin of beans is like a cylinder.



Talk Homework – How do we bring about change through the things we do? How do we help others in need?
