To celebrate and encourage a lifelong love of reading at home and school, we will be running a sponsored reading challenge week <u>running from</u> Monday 17<sup>st</sup> June 2019 until Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> June. This will be followed by the reading celebration day mentioned on the previous page of this letter on the 21<sup>st</sup> June.

Ticket sales are limited to first come, first served. You can purchase these via Parentmail. Tickets <u>must</u> be purchased <u>before</u> the disco. If you have any questions about making payments on Parentmail, please see the school office for help and support.

If your child wishes to come to the disco, they will be taken to the school hall by their teacher and then you will be able to collect your child from their **Classroom door at 5.00pm.** 

As usual, there will be drinks, hotdogs, sweets and disco toys to buy. Please send your child's spending money in a **sealed, named** envelope. This will be kept safe by the class teacher. Please keep the amount to a **maximum of £3 for KS1 (infants) and £5 for KS2 (juniors).** This will reduce the risk of children losing their change.

On the day, **all** children in school can come in non-uniform **with a £1 donation (this is separate to the disco ticket price)**. This will save the children who attend the disco having to get changed and will reduce the risk of any lost items.
