This week we have been learning:

This week the children have been learning about families and we have been talking about who is important to us. The children have sketched their own family and we have made some wonderful art work.

In Maths this week we have been learning about 3D shapes. We have been on a shape hunt and we have found everyday objects that remind us of the different shapes.

Children also enjoyed their moving up day on Thursday. They have spent some time in their new classes and met their new teachers.

Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

Literacy/Phonics – Practise writing words with the **ow** phoneme. Such as; cow, brown, now, crown, down etc. (Say the word to your child and ask them to sound talk and write the phonemes they can hear).

Practise writing words with the **ur** phoneme. Such as; burn, turn, church, nurse etc. (Say the word to your child and ask them to sound talk and write the phonemes they can hear).

Mathematics – Please spend time showing and talking to your child about the time. If you have a clock it would help prepare your child if they understood time on the hour e.g. 5 o'clock, 6 o'clock etc.

Talk Homework – How we feel when our families change? Is it easy or difficult? What kind of changes have you faced?

PE will be on a Thursday each week. Please ensure your child has the correct kit in school.
