Dear Parents,

This week we have been learning:

This week the children have been completing their end of term assessments with the teachers. It has been just marvellous to see how far the children have come this year; not just academically, but in their confidence and social skills too. We have had such a fabulous year teaching your children and working with families (with lots of laughs and tears along the way!) and will miss all of the children so very much. It is always so lovely to see them progressing through the school and think about what they were like when they first started! Good luck to our three families who are joining new schools, please do let us know how you get on.

Summer Homework

Literacy ask your child to write their name once every day, it is amazing how quickly young children can forget how to hold a pencil correctly or form the letters in their name.

Phonics Continue to revise all of the sounds taught this term. Make simple words with the letters and encourage your child to use their 'sound talk' to read. Encourage your child to write through play, e.g. write an invitation to a friend to play, write a list of mini-beasts that they can find in the garden, role play cafes and write the food that the customer wants. When writing like this, it is not essential that the children write the words correctly, just encourage them to write the sounds they can hear in the word.

Mathematics Continue to introduce your child to new numbers. Most children recognize numbers up to 10 and are working on numbers to 20, a few children are recognizing numbers up to 100 and a few are working on number recognition to 5. Play 'snap' with number cards, count how many teddies are on the bed and place the correct number on them, look at the numbers on the shopping aisles in Asda or on buses.

Talk Homework Plan out your Summer holidays. Talk to your child about what they will be doing and perhaps draw a simple calendar, e.g. week 1 – relaxing at home, week 2 – park, beach, etc.

Physical development

Our last PE session will be on Monday with Mr Morris.
