### **This week we have been learning:**

In English this week we have continued working on Orion and the Dark by Emma Yarlett. We have been focusing on punctuation and have looked at using inverted commas to punctuate direct speech (speech marks). We have also done some work on word classes and have been writing expanded noun phrases. In maths, we have continued working on place value. Year 3 have concentrated on 3 digit numbers and Year 4 have moved onto numbers up to 10,000. We have worked on positioning and estimating numbers on a number line, they children have found this quite a challenge.

**Maths:** Estimating on a number line.
