### This week we have been learning:

This week the children have been learning about themselves. They have been using different media to create portraits including; paint and collage. They have been talking about what they enjoy and things they are good at. In Maths we have been doing lots of counting forwards and backwards, the children have been counting objects and we have been ordering numbers.

### Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

I have attached a number sheet (if you are unable to print the numbers please write your own number cards for your child to use) during the week can you spend time playing different games with these numbers. Below are a few examples of what you can do;

- Play snap
- Jumble them up and order them – time your child, can they do it faster next time!
- Pick a card and find that number of objects around the house e.g. 5 grapes, 6 socks
- Play hide and seek with the numbers or do a number treasure hunt.
- Look, cover and then write the number
- Play number bingo
- Practise forming the numbers using different writing tools e.g. chalk, paint, pencil, sticks in mud/sand etc.

\*\*\*First start with numbers to 10, when you feel your child to happy with numbers to 10 challenge them with numbers to 20. It'll be useful to keep these resources at home and continue to practise throughout the year, adding bigger numbers when your child is ready.
