Another busy week! Here's what we've been up to...

This week we have been learning:

In English we have been learning to write a dictated sentence. The children have been concentrating on writing their sentences with finger spaces between words, capital letters at the beginning and full stops at the end.

In Maths we have been counting objects and comparing which is most and least.

In Science we have been learning about our different body parts. We will be learning about our five senses and how important they are to our everyday life. Next week we will be focusing on our sense of sight.

In Geography work we have been learning the names of all the trusted adults in our school.

In Music we have been learning to keep to the beat by tapping our knees, clapping our hands, tapping our feet. It was lots of fun!

In RE we have been talking about how God felt when He created the world. The children have been expressing their thanks for our beautiful world and all that God created in it.

Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

English: Year 1s Write sentence using the pictures on the sheet to help you. The first one has been done for you.

Reception: Write the initial sounds of the pictures on the sheet provided.

Maths: This week we have been talking about odd and even numbers. Think about the numbers 1-10, which numbers are odd and which are even? Can you explain what makes them 'odd' and what makes them 'even'? Explain to an adult in your house (this does not need to be recorded in your books).

Phonics: Enclosed is a spelling homework sheet (Year 1 children only). This sheet has five words which your child will be tested on next Friday. It also contains the Phonics sounds we have focused on this week. These words **will not** be tested in class. Spelling tests will be completed in the back of the homework books so you can see which words they got correct. Spelling tests will be every Friday.

Talk Homework: Have you had times when you are worried about something? Who do you share your problems with? Does it help?

PE

PE takes place on Wednesdays. PE kits consist of; Black shorts, red polo shirt and black pumps. Please leave PE kits in school during term time
