## Dear Parents,

Another busy week! Here's what we've been up to...

### **This week we have been learning:**

In English we have continued to focus on writing sentences, sitting our letters on the line, leaving finger spaces and putting capital letters and full stops in the correct places. The children have enjoyed building their own sentences. In Maths we have been using the language greater than, fewer than and equal to when comparing numbers and objects.

In Science we have been learning about our sense of sight. We took part in an experiment to see if we could see just as well with one eye as with two eyes. Can your child remember what our results were?

In Geography work we have been learning about the towns, cities and villages that are in our local area.

In Art we have been painting self-portraits.

In RE we have been talking about Harvest. We have been discussing how God provides all the food that we need and how we can show God's love by sharing our food with others.

### **Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)**

**Geography:** If you visit a town, village or city this weekend please take a photo/write it down in your homework books so we can share it with the rest of the class.

**Maths:** Enclosed in your homework bags is a sheet to complete.

**Phonics:** Spelling homework sheet (Year 1 children only). This sheet has five words which your child will be tested on next Friday. It also contains the Phonics sounds we have focused on this week. These words **will not** be tested in class. Spelling tests will be completed in the back of the homework books so you can see which words they got correct. Spelling tests will be every Friday.

**Talk Homework: How does food get from the farm to the shops? Do we say thank you enough for the food we are given?**

## **PE**

PE takes place on Wednesdays. PE kits consist of; Black shorts, red polo shirt and black pumps. Please leave PE kits in school during term time
