This week we have been learning:

English: We finished our retelling of the story of Polar the Titanic Bear. The children learnt that they needed to include an introduction, middle part and then the end of the story. I can see that the children have made so much progress already.

Maths: We have been working out 10 more and 10 less than a number. We were discussing which of the digits changed each time we added 10. We have also recapped on one more and one less than a given number.

Maths: A mixture of our work from this week

Phonics/Spelling: look, say, cover, check write spellings in homework book.

Talk Homework: Why do people move around the world? How can we help those in need?
