### This week we have been learning:

In English this week we have been working on instructional texts. We have been working on fronted adverbials and imperative (instructional) verbs. We have written our own sets of instructions for how to make a torch. In maths, we have continued to focus on addition of 2, 3 and 4 digit numbers and we have introduced the formal written method and the children have made fantastic progress.

### Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

**RE:** This half term we have been learning all about prayer. We have learnt that it does not matter where or how we pray because God will always listen.
