**Knowledge Organiser:** What would Jim Hawkins/Kensuke think of the world today? This continues with our Geography focus as we look at the journeys made around the world and continue to work on Treasure Island and our new text Kensuke's Kingdom.

**Phonics/Spelling:** Year 6 spellings with personal gaps from age related expectation spellings.

**Talk Homework:** Why do we wear a poppy? What helps us to remember and never forget important people and events?

**PE :** will continue to be on a Friday. Please ensure your child has the correct kit in school. This term we are learning about stamina and developing ball skills, reaction and response.
