Dear Parents,

This week we have been learning:

In Maths this week we have been looking at two dimensional shapes and their properties. We have also looked at regular and irregular shapes.

In English we have started to look at our new book 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jefferson, we have discussed what we think the book might be about regarding the title, discussed and investigated the language that we might not be familiar with, we have read the story and discussed the emotions of the characters involved.

In topic, our new title is 'Why can't penguins live near the equator?', we looked at where the penguin lives and why it is best suited to that type of environment, we have also looked at where the equator is and what the countries on, and near the equator is like.

Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

English: Can you tell the people at home what our story is about?

Maths: Can you draw a triangle, regular quadrilateral, irregular quadrilateral and an irregular pentagon?.

Spelling (Year 1): look, say, cover, check, write spellings – you, your, they, he and be.

Spelling (Year 2): look, say, cover, check, write spellings – wild, climb, most, only and both.

Talk Homework: Why do we wear a poppy? What helps us to remember and never important people and events?
