This week we have been learning:

In English we have been looking at the vocabulary in our class text Leaf Man. We have learnt what marshy ground is like, what an orchard is and what a **flock** of birds means

In Maths we have been learning subtract numbers. We have been calculating one less than a given number. The children have been fantastic at this!

In Science we have been learning about the seasons. We talked about the differences between the four seasons and how it feels right now in Autumn!

In Geography work we have been looking at the features of Royton and how it compares to other towns such as Blackpool.

In Art we have been doing leaf rubbings and bark rubbings.

Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

Next week we are going to be learning about 3D shapes. In preparation for this work, please could you collect some real 3D shapes from home for us to look at. We will be initially looking at the 3D shapes; cylinder, cube, sphere and cuboid. Some examples of what you could collect are shown below;
