Dear Parents,

Thank you for all the 3D shapes that were brought in this week. We have sorted them into cubes, cuboids, spheres and cylinders. We have been learning how many faces they have got and whether they are curved or flat. We have used the playdough to create our own 3D shapes too!

This week we have been learning:

In English we have been looking at the type of leaves that Leaf man was made out of and writing about them.

In Maths we have been learning about 3D shapes.

In Science we have been drawing what the trees look like in each of the four seasons.

In Geography work we have been thinking about the journey that Leaf man will have made from Dunwood park to our school.

In Art we have been doing leaf printing.

Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday)

English: Label the body parts of Leaf Man.

Phonics: Spelling homework sheet (Year 1 children only). This sheet has five words which your child will be tested on next Friday. It also contains the Phonics sounds we have focused on this week. These words **will not** be tested in class. Spelling tests will be completed in the back of the homework books so you can see which words they got correct. Spelling tests will be every Friday.

Talk Homework: **Have you ever fallen out with someone? What were the reasons? How did you make friends again?**
