This week we have been learning:

We will be continuing this topic next week by talking about people who help us in our community. If your child has had an experience of being helped by a policeman/woman, a doctor, a nurse, a firefighter and they are willing to share their experience with the rest of the class, please they write some simple sentences about it in their homework book.

Year 1 please write about how you were helped in the past.

Reception please draw a picture of the person/people who helped you in the past and try to write a simple caption to go with your picture.

Please bring the 3D shapes in a named carrier bag which can be kept on their coat hooks. Thank you.

Phonics: Spelling homework sheet (Year 1 children only). This sheet has five words which your child will be tested on next Friday. It also contains the Phonics sounds we have focused on this week. These words **will not** be tested in class. Spelling tests will be completed in the back of the homework books so you can see which words they got correct. Spelling tests will be every Friday.

Talk Homework: **Talk: Do our choices have consequences? What do you need to do to achieve your goals?**
