This week we have been learning:

In Maths year 1 children have been learning to count on from any given number, and they have done fantastic! So much so, we were able to move on to next week's work a bit earlier; therefore, we have started to look at number bonds to 10 and 20, which they made a good start on, but we will be carrying this on into next week.

The year 2 children have started to look at division, we have been sharing cubes into different sizes of groups, at the beginning they found this hard a bit tricky, however, they did not give up and continued to work very hard and have turned a corner with their understanding and method.

In English we have started our new class book; Beegu, which we have really enjoyed reading and discussing. We have looked at how the Beegu feels and what she thinks about the situation she has found herself in.

Homework (handed out on a Friday and due in the following Thursday)

English: Can you tell an adult at home what we have read up to in Beegu and tell them what you think is going to happen?

Maths: At the **bottom** of the newsletter.

Phonics/Spelling: look, say, cover, check, write spellings – mum, bone, cone, flute, brute, nice, twirl, boy.

Talk Homework: What are your goals? What would you like to achieve? What obstacles might get in your way? How would you overcome this?
