**Dear Parents,**

Another busy week in Blue Class.

## **This week we have been learning:**

**English:** This week we have planned and written our informal letter. The children have worked hard to learn the features of an informal letter and have applied them to their own letter.

**Maths:** This week we have used the multiplication (x) sign in number sentences this week and used it to understand equal groups. We have learnt that multiplication is commutative and this means it can be done in any order. So  $3 \times 2$  gives the same answer as  $2 \times 3$ . We also learnt that  $3 \times 2$  is the same as 3 equal groups of 2 and 3 lots of 2

## **Homework (handed out on a Thursday and due in the following Wednesday)**

**English:** SPaG sheet

**Maths:** A mix of quiz questions and a speed crunch.

**Phonics/Spelling:** look, say, cover, check write spellings in homework book.

**Talk Homework:** Do we always make the right choice? What do we need to do to always make the right choice?
