This week we have been learning:

In Maths year 1 children have been learning what number bonds to 10 and 20 are, they have worked fantastically and I have been very impressed! Later this week we have been looking at calculations and partitioning numbers, we found this hard and will continue with this next week.

The year 2 children have been sharing objects equally between groups, at first we found this a bit of a challenge, but after some hard work, we were able to get through it and do a good job.

Well done everyone in their Maths this week! Give yourselves a pat on the back.

In English we have finished our book; Beegu, which really enjoyed reading and discussing. We have looked at how the Beegu feels and what she thinks about the situation she has found herself in, we have started to create a story map and will be writing a recount of the story next week. Phonics/Spelling: look, say, cover, check, write spellings – pie, cried, smile, tick, India.
