Dear Parents,

This week we have been learning:

We have been meeting some real live Superheros! On Tuesday Sean from Oldham Mountain Rescue came to tell us all about the fantastic work they do. He showed us some of the special equipment that they use, and what happens during a rescue. On Friday we were visited by the Fire Brigade, who shared with us some of the amazing work that they do. We have been reading 'The Very Helpful Hedgehog' and talking about how we can help others and how important it is help others. In maths we have been learning more about addition. We have learnt how to use a stem sentence as we add. For example; 5 is a part, 5 is a part and the whole is 10. We have also been practising writing numbers. This will help us greatly as we begin to record more in our maths sessions. We have been learning a song to help us remember how to form the numbers correctly.


