

English: Our focus stories are: I am Too Absolutely Small for School, The Colour Monster and Starting School. We will be enjoying a range of books and learning how to talk about these with an understanding of story language. We will be using narrative language within shared reading- Who? Where? When? What happened?

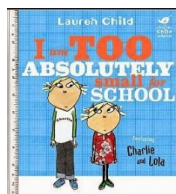
Maths: We will be exploring numbers to 10 and understanding the value of these numbers. We will be sorting objects and using reasoning to explain how we have done this. We will be comparing groups using mathematical vocabulary such as more, less, longer, shorter.

We will begin to explore simple addition and subtraction within groups up to 10.

Science We will be learning to identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body. We will be learning about our five senses.

Computing We will be learning how to keep safe on the Internet. We will be learning how to use the keyboard on the laptops to type our name.

Art and Design: We will be using loose parts to create portraits. We will work together to print with a variety of objects, including natural and made objects.

RE:
 God made each one of us the same but different. We are unique. We are made in the image of God, he knows everything about us and he loves us.

Homework: Homework will be set every **Friday** and must be return the following **Wednesday**. This includes reading books which need to be returned to be changed. Children need to read their books and fill out their reading records. We encourage all parents to listen to their child read and to also sign the reading record to confirm the book has been read. The children will have their homework and reading book in their homework folders on Friday.

PSED: Recognising different feelings and emotions. Identify emotion pictures and how we might feel if in similar situations.

Geography: We will be learning about our school and which town our school is in. We will be learning about towns, villages and cities and which ones are near our school.

Phonics: We will be learning to recognise Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds and learning to segment them together to create new words.

Physical Development: We will be learning how to move our bodies and develop co-ordination. We will be developing fine motor skills through activities during 'funky fingers' time.
